Slated for Federal Ownership as part of MNWR New Land Preserved

The 300 Committee recently acquired 578 acros of words on the Painouth-Mashpee town line. Furthesed from Michael Croshoy of Oxis, MA, this wearn land pared is home to sensitive webral and plant communities. Within a year or two, T5C will convey the Cochoy land to the US Fish & Willife Service for inclusion in the Mashpee National Willife Refuge. This collaboration with a federal agency is a ground-breaking partnership for T5C.

The parcel is accessed from North Ockway Road in Waquoti and is adjacent to a parcel protected by the Ocenda Wildlife Land Tract. Because of its wethouts and nearly 1,100 feer of frontage along feed Brook — which flows into Harbini Pond and Little Kner, because in perpenning timo Waquoti Bay — it is hugh in conservation value and worthy of protection in perpenning.
